



## Statement Regarding RoHS Compliance

To Our Valued Customer,

Colder Products Company manufactures quick disconnect couplings and connections made from a variety of metal, plastic, and elastomeric raw materials. The purpose of this statement is to clarify the position of Colder Products Company on compliance with “**The Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment (European Council Directive 2002/95/EC)**,” commonly referred to as “RoHS.”

According to our suppliers and to the best of our knowledge, the raw materials and manufacturing processes used in the standard and modified standard product lines do not possess levels of cadmium, lead, mercury, hexavalent chromium, PBB or PBDE beyond acceptable limits as identified in the RoHS regulation. However, be advised that Colder Products Company does not test products for these substances.
